

## **Software Gift Lifts KIDS Center to New Heights**

Bend, Oregon--Unifi Technologies, Inc. of Bend has completed installation of **Unifi-Med**, a full function software management suite for the KIDS Center, a regional non-profit provider of comprehensive medical evaluations and treatment for children suspected of having been abused as well as community-based prevention programs.

The installation and customization of the software was made possible by a donation from Tim and Martha McGinnis, owners of Bend-based **Unifi Technologies**.

According to Bob Smit, executive director of the KIDS Center, the move to digitize record keeping will greatly increase operating efficiency of the agency as well as provide new opportunities to deliver its services throughout all of central and eastern Oregon.

Smit explained that KIDS Center referrals come via law enforcement, medical communities and child welfare entities, almost all of who submit their records in paper form. Each KIDS Center client and referral can generate massive background and evaluative files that have clogged the Bend-based agency with literally tons of paper.

Using Unifi Technologies' software, the KIDS Center is able to receive and store all referral and treatment documents electronically, virtually eliminating its physical storage woes and greatly enhancing its ability to provide efficient centralized administrative support to a larger geographic area. In addition, when fully deployed, KIDS Center medical practitioners will be able to utilize the latest in technologies to capture and store examination and evaluation information without the need to create paper-based chart notes.

According to Smit, "This is the culmination of a five-year vision process and plan by the KIDS Center board and management. Because of these new efficiencies we can now serve more communities as well as do a better job of cross-consulting with remote medical staff, law enforcement and child welfare service partners. It is truly a wonderful gift."

The efficiencies will help facilitate the opening of a new satellite office in Crook County, likely the first of several that Smit acknowledges would not have been possible without the new system.

Donor Tim McGinnis said, "Today's non-profit enterprises face an enormous legal and financial reporting burden and we felt that we could tailor our software to help places like the KIDS Center do what they do best by making their management software more efficient. It was a pleasure to be able to help an agency as important as The KIDS Center."
